VHR history

This site was located during an M.A.A.V. field day at Tarwin Lower. The site appears to be that of small wooden sailing vessel of less than 50 tons. Little remains except for four paired frames which just poke above the sand. Scantling size indicates quite a small vessel. Despite the above, the timber on the beach was straight and did not resemble any part of a ship. It was not shaped or moulded. If it was from a vessel, it may have been the engine bed, but there were no fastening holes to indicate this.
