## **VHR** history

"In April 1844 the Geelong Advertiser published a paragraph concerning a rumour that claimed that local Aboriginals had reported the loss of a vessel near Moonlight Head. They also stated that other natives had killed the crew, and another report said that only two, a woman and a child survived to reach the shore. The remoteness of the region apparently prevented a full scale search being organised and nothing further was heard" (Loney, 1989: 42)
