VHR history

The Gippsland Guardian reported on 13 March 1860 that a 120 feet length of ship's keel from a vessel "of light build" was washed ashore on Ninety Mile Beach .

 The Gippsland Times on the same day reported that a portion of wreck bearing the name of the Mayflower "wrecked some years since" was washed up near Mr Letts' station along with a red buoy "in good order" marked No. 57.
