Statement of significance

The site is significant as part of the resource of at least six known vessels abandoned within the Jawbone Marine Sanctuary.

VHR history

The site is scattered and broken up with iron frames, steering gear and a rudder. A small brass bell and large timbers with pintles are known to have been recovered from the site in around 1986. It used to be thought the site was the Agnes but now is not.
