Statement of significance

This unidentified site is part of a resource of at least six vessels known to have been deliberately abandoned behind Williamstown Rifle Range, within the Jawbone Marine Sanctuary. All these sites are recreationally and educationally significant reminders of Williamstown's, and Port Phillip's maritime industrial heritage.

VHR history

The site consists of iron pipe, hawse pipe, and copper alloy fastenings, with no timbers observed. It has been broken up and scattered on a rock and sand seabed.
