The BLUEBIRD was originally used for towing barges between San Remo and Newhaven on Phillip Island. The construction of a larger punt in the late 1920s made the BLUEBIRD redundant. According to Woodley, the vessel was converted into a fishing vessel prior to it being lost some time in 1945.
